

## Wyoming County Fairgrounds Streambank Restoration Project

April 7, 2005 - August 9, 2006

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Looking downstream, you can see that the right bank is nearly vertical as a result of severe erosion.

## Trunks from nearby trees were cut to serve as new revetments.





Smaller branches were cut and soaked to promote root growth and sustain viability until planted. Volunteers from the DEC and Trout Unlimited shock the stream to safely remove the trout before construction begins.





Concrete barriers are placed in the channel to divert the flow into the preexisting overflow channel during construction.

A tree trunk is placed back in the bank to serve as a tieback key. Live stakes are planted as well.





The excavator lowers the large tree trunks, which are then secured with cable to another log buried in the streambank.

Looking downstream, the new revetments are visible, as are the live stakes. The floodplain is now gently sloped, rather than vertical.





Using large rocks, a grade control structure is created, to prevent stream down cutting.



The newly constructed floodplain is hydroseeded.



The hydroseeding is covered with a straw mulch.

Fencing is put up to limit access to the streambank.
